TASK

To gather useful information about environmental issues and resource use for your club

EQUIPMENT

Pencils, clipboards, Resource sheet 2 (or your own) , calculator, ruler.

ACTIVITY

- Information on environmental topics of interest or concern can help people make simple changes that minimise the impact we have on the environment.
- First you need to choose the topic or question and then gather the information through counting, observing, questioning or interviewing.
- You will need to show what you find out using tables or graphs.
- Decide whether a problem exists or not
- Share your information with interested club members through a poster, letter ,email, report or presentation.



Some possible topics:

- Lighting:

Where are lights located?
How many lights are low energy bulbs?
Which lights are used most frequently?

- Rubbish

Where are bins located?
How many bins are for specific types of waste?
Which bins are used most frequently?
What is thrown away most often?
What is the most difficult item to dispose of ?

- Water use

Where are taps and hoses located?
Are any hoses fitted with trigger nozzles?
Which taps or hoses are used most frequently?
Where is the greatest amount of water used?
